

VETERAN'S PREFERENCE:

Preference is extended to certain eligible veterans and spouses of veterans. If you desire to claim Veteran's Preference, check which applies.

eligible for or is receiving compensation under public laws administered by the U. S.	The spouse of a veteran who cannot qualify for employment because of a total and permanent disability, or the spouse of a veteran missing in action, captured or forcibly detained by a foreign power; or the spouse of a wartime veteran;	on active duty for 180 consecutive days or more and was honorably discharged from the U.S. Armed Forces	The unmarried widow or widower of a veteran who died of a service-connected disability.
